

# C A L E N D A R

of Bible Readings



In the Calendar that follows, which is adapted from that of the 1662 Book of Common Prayer, there is both a normal course of everyday readings and a sequence proper to higher holy days, which are chiefly the various Lord's Days and the major feasts and fasts of the church. The lessons proper to the higher holy days – that is, belonging to those days – take priority over the usual course of readings, but sometimes a Saturday or a Monday can be used to double up on readings so as to avoid an unnecessary gap in the reading of the holy Scriptures.

In the university setting, of course, not every day may be free for students to gather for both Morning Prayer and Evening Prayer, but it is hoped that said students will either read the Scriptures on their own or else find suitable points at which to, say, use the morning lessons in the public saying of Evening Prayer, if that be convenient. It is seemly, in any case, that those who cannot attend daily prayers should not be hindered entirely from prayer: an alternative as simple as the Apostles' Creed followed by the Lord's Prayer will at least foster a prayerful heart, though it be not as full a participation in public prayer, and can be used by the Christian who wishes to join his heart with those of his brethren who are employing themselves together in prayer. Since the business of this booklet is not private devotions but public prayer, so much will suffice on that point.

For the reading of the Collect of the Day, sometimes there will be more than one collect to be read. In the second week of Advent, for example, the Collect for the First Sunday of Advent is to be read after the Collect for the Second Sunday of Advent. Likewise, on 27 December, the feast day of Saint John, Apostle and Evangelist, first will be read the collect proper to his commemoration, and then the collect which remembers the birth of our Lord Jesus Christ; and on All Saints' Day will be read first the Collect for All Saints' Day, and then the collect for the Sunday whose week it is. Moving through these collects, together with the Scriptures, will bring to mind the great themes of our faith: from Advent to Trinity, the life and doctrine of Christ; after Trinity, our growth in holiness after the pattern, and in the body, of our Savior.

## *Second Sunday of Advent*

BLESSED Lord, who has caused all holy Scriptures to be written for our learning; Grant that we may in such manner hear them, read, mark, learn, and inwardly digest them, that by patience and comfort from your holy Word we may embrace, and ever hold fast, the blessed hope of everlasting life, which you have given us in our Savior Jesus Christ. *Amen.*

## *Third Sunday of Advent*

O LORD Jesus Christ, who at your first coming did send your messenger to prepare your way before you; Grant that the ministers and stewards of your mysteries may likewise so prepare and make ready your way, by turning the hearts of the disobedient to the wisdom of the just, that at your second coming to judge the world we may be found an acceptable people in the sight of you, who live and reign with the Father and the Holy Spirit ever, one God, world without end. *Amen.*

## *Fourth Sunday of Advent*

O LORD, raise up (we call upon you) your power, and come among us, and with great might relieve us; that whereas, through our sins

and wickedness, we are sorely obstructed and hindered in running the race that is set before us, your bountiful grace and mercy may speedily help and deliver us; through the satisfaction of your Son our Lord, to whom with you and the Holy Ghost be honor and glory, world without end. *Amen.*

*Christmas Day*

ALMIGHTY God, who have given us your only-begotten Son to take our nature upon him, and as at this time to be born of a pure Virgin; Grant that we, being regenerate, and made your children by adoption and grace, may daily be renewed by your Holy Spirit; through the same our Lord Jesus Christ, who lives and reigns with you and the same Spirit, ever one God, world without end. *Amen.*

*Saint Stephen, Deacon and Martyr*

GRANT, O Lord, that, in all our sufferings here upon earth for the testimony of your truth, we may steadfastly look up to heaven, and by faith behold the glory that shall be revealed; and, being filled with the Holy Ghost, may learn to love and bless our persecutors by the example of your first Martyr Saint Stephen, who prayed for his murderers to you, O blessed Jesus, who stand at the right hand of God to help all those who suffer for you, our only Mediator and Advocate. *Amen.*

*Saint John, Apostle and Evangelist*

MERCIFUL Lord, we beseech you to cast your bright beams of light upon your Church, that, being enlightened by the doctrine of your blessed Apostle and Evangelist Saint John, it may so walk in the light of your truth, that it may at length attain to the light of everlasting life; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*The Holy Innocents*

O ALMIGHTY God, who out of the mouths of babes and sucklings have ordained strength, & made infants to glorify you by their deaths;

Mortify and kill all vices in us, and so strengthen us by your grace, that by the innocency of our lives, and constancy of our faith even to the point of death, we may glorify your holy Name; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*The Circumcision of Christ*

ALMIGHTY God, who made your blessed Son to be circumcised, and obedient to the law for man; Grant us the true Circumcision of the Spirit; that, our hearts, and all our members, being mortified from all worldly and carnal lusts, we may in all things obey your blessed will; through the same your Son Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*The Epiphany, or the Manifestation of Christ to the Gentiles*

O GOD, who by the leading of a star did manifest your only-begotten Son to the Gentiles: Mercifully grant that we, who know you now by faith, may after this life know the fullness of your glorious Godhead; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*The First Sunday after the Epiphany*

O LORD, we entreat you to receive mercifully the prayers of your people who call upon you; and grant that they may both perceive and know what things they ought to do, and also may have grace and power faithfully to fulfill the same; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*The Second Sunday after the Epiphany*

ALMIGHTY and everlasting God, who govern all things in heaven and earth; Mercifully hear the supplications of your people, and grant us your peace all the days of our life; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*The Third Sunday after the Epiphany*

ALMIGHTY and everlasting God, mercifully look upon our frailties, and in all our dangers and necessities stretch forth your right hand to help and defend us; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*The Fourth Sunday after the Epiphany*

O GOD, who know us to be set in the midst of so many and great dangers, that because of the frailty of our nature we cannot always stand upright; Grant to us such strength and protection, as may support us in all dangers, and carry us through all temptations; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*The Fifth Sunday after the Epiphany*

O LORD, we entreat you to keep your Church and household continually in your true religion; that they who lean only upon the hope of your heavenly grace may evermore be defended by your mighty power; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*The Sixth Sunday after the Epiphany*

O GOD, whose blessed Son was manifested to destroy the works of the devil, and make us the sons of God, and heirs of eternal life; Grant us, we entreat you, that, having this hope, we may purify ourselves, even as he is pure; that, when he shall appear again with power and great glory, we may be made like him in his eternal and glorious kingdom; where with you, O Father, and you, O Holy Ghost, he lives and reigns, ever one God, world without end. *Amen.*

*The Sunday called Septuagesima, or the third Sunday before Lent*

O LORD, we entreat you to hear favorably the prayers of your people; that we, who are justly punished for our offenses, may be mercifully delivered by your goodness, for the glory of your Name; through Jesus Christ our Savior, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Ghost, ever one God, world without end. *Amen.*

*The Sunday called Sexagesima, or the second Sunday before Lent*

O LORD God, seeing that we do not put our trust in any thing that we do; Mercifully grant that by your power we may be defended against all adversity; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*The Sunday called Quinquagesima, or the next Sunday before Lent*

O LORD, who have taught us that all our doings without charity are worth nothing; Send your Holy Ghost and pour into our hearts that most excellent gift of charity, the very bond of peace and of all virtues, without which whosoever lives is counted dead before you; Grant this for the sake of your only Son Jesus Christ. *Amen.*

*The First day of Lent,  
Commonly called Ash Wednesday*

ALMIGHTY and everlasting God, who hate nothing that you have made, and do forgive the sins of all those who are penitent; Create and make in us new and contrite hearts, that we, worthily lamenting our sins, and acknowledging our wretchedness, may obtain of thee, the God of all mercy, perfect remission and forgiveness; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*The Collect above is to be repeated throughout Lent.*

*The First Sunday in Lent*

O LORD, who for our sake fasted forty days and forty nights; Give us grace to use such abstinence, that, with our flesh being subdued to the Spirit, we may ever obey when you move us, in righteousness and true holiness, to your honor and glory, as you live and reign with the Father and the Holy Ghost, one God, world without end. *Amen.*

*The Second Sunday in Lent*

ALMIGHTY God, who see that we have no power of ourselves to help ourselves; Keep us both outwardly in our bodies, and inwardly in our souls; that we may be defended from all adversities which may happen to the body, and from all evil thoughts which may assault and hurt the soul; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*The Third Sunday in Lent*

WE implore you, Almighty God, look upon the hearty desires of your humble servants, and stretch forth the right hand of your Majesty,



to be our defense against all our enemies; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*The Fourth Sunday in Lent*

GRANT, we implore you, Almighty God, that we, who for our evil deeds do worthily deserve to be punished, may by the comfort of your grace be mercifully relieved; through our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. *Amen.*

*The Fifth Sunday in Lent*

WE implore you, Almighty God, to look mercifully upon your people; that by your great goodness they may be governed and preserved evermore, both in body and soul; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*The Sunday next before Easter*

ALMIGHTY and everlasting God, who in your tender love toward mankind have sent your Son, our Savior Jesus Christ, to take upon him our flesh, and to suffer death upon the cross, that all mankind should follow the example of his great humility; Mercifully grant that we may both follow the example of his patience, and also be made partakers of his resurrection; through the same Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*Good Friday*

ALMIGHTY God, we beseech you graciously to behold this your family, for whom our Lord Jesus Christ was contented to be betrayed, and given up into the hands of wicked men, and to suffer death upon the cross, who now lives and reigns with you and the Holy Ghost, ever one God, world without end. *Amen.*

ALMIGHTY and everlasting God, by whose Spirit the whole body of the Church is governed and sanctified; Receive our supplications and prayers, which we offer before you for all estates of men in your holy Church, that every member of the same, in his vocation and ministry may truly and godly serve you; through our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. *Amen.*

O MERCIFUL God, who have made all men, and hate nothing that you have made, nor do wish that a sinner should die, but rather that he should be converted and live; Have mercy upon all Jews, Muslims, Infidels, and Heretics, and take from them all ignorance, hardness of heart, and contempt of your Word; and so fetch them home, blessed Lord, to your flock, that they may be saved among the remnant of the true Israelites, and be made one fold under one shepherd, Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, world without end. *Amen.*

*Easter Even*

GRANT, O Lord, that as we are baptized into the death of your blessed Son our Savior Jesus Christ, so by continual mortifying of our corrupt affections we may be buried with him; and that through the grave, and gate of death, we may pass to our joyful resurrection; for the merits of him who died, and was buried, and rose again for us, your Son Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*Easter Day*

ALMIGHTY God, who through your only-begotten Son Jesus Christ have overcome death, and opened to us the gate of everlasting life; We humbly entreat you, that, as by your special grace preceding us you do put into our minds good desires, so by your continual help we may bring these to good effect; through Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Ghost, ever one God, world without end. *Amen.*

*First Sunday after Easter*

ALMIGHTY Father, who have given your only Son to die for our sins, and to rise again for our justification; Grant us so to put away the leaven of malice & wickedness, that we may always serve you in pureness of living and truth; through the merits of the same your Son Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*Second Sunday after Easter*

ALMIGHTY God, who have given your only Son to be to us both a sacrifice for sin, and also an example of godly life; Give us grace that

we may always most thankfully receive that his inestimable benefit, and also daily endeavor ourselves to follow the blessed steps of his most holy life; through the same Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*Third Sunday after Easter*

ALMIGHTY God, who show to those who are in error the light of your truth, to the intent that they may return into the way of righteousness; Grant to all those who are admitted into the fellowship of Christ's Religion, that they may eschew those things which are contrary to their profession, and follow all such things as are agreeable to the same; through our Lord Jesus Christ. *Amen.*

*Fourth Sunday after Easter*

O ALMIGHTY God, who alone can order the unruly wills and affections of sinful men; Grant to your people, that they may love the thing which you command, and desire that which you promise; that so, among the various and manifold changes of the world, our hearts may surely there be fixed, where true joys are to be found; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*Fifth Sunday after Easter*

O LORD, from whom all good things do come; Grant to us your humble servants, that by your holy inspiration we may think those things that are good, and by your merciful guiding may perform the same; through our Lord Jesus Christ. *Amen.*

*Ascension Day*

GRANT, we entreat you, Almighty God, that as we believe your only-begotten Son our Lord Jesus Christ to have ascended into the heavens; so we may also in heart and mind thither ascend, and with him continually dwell, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Ghost, one God, world without end. *Amen.*

*Sunday after Ascension*

O GOD the King of glory, who have exalted your only Son Jesus Christ with great triumph to your kingdom in heaven; We entreat you,

do not leave us comfortless; but send to us your Holy Ghost to comfort us, and exalt us to the same place whither our Savior Christ has gone before, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Ghost, one God, world without end. *Amen.*

*Whitsunday*

GOD, who as at this time did teach the hearts of your faithful people, by the sending to them the light of your Holy Spirit; Grant us by the same Spirit to have a right judgment in all things, and evermore to rejoice in his holy comfort; through the merits of Christ Jesus our Savior, who lives and reigns with you, in the unity of the same Spirit, one God, world without end. *Amen.*

*Trinity Sunday*

ALMIGHTY and everlasting God, who have given to us your servants grace, by the confession of a true faith to acknowledge the glory of the eternal Trinity, and in the power of your Divine Majesty to worship the Unity; We entreat you, that you would keep us steadfast in this faith, and evermore defend us from all adversities, as you live and reign, one God, world without end. *Amen.*

*First Sunday after Trinity*

O GOD, the strength of all those who put their trust in you, mercifully accept our prayers; and because through the weakness of our mortal nature we can do no good thing without you, grant us the help of your grace, that in keeping of your commandments we may please you, both in will and deed; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*Second Sunday after Trinity*

O LORD, who never fail to help and govern those whom you bring up in your steadfast fear and love; Keep us, we entreat you, under the protection of your good providence, and make us to have a perpetual fear and love of your holy Name; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*Third Sunday after Trinity*

O LORD, we entreat you mercifully to hear us; and grant that we, to whom you have given a hearty desire to pray, may by your mighty aid be defended and comforted in all dangers and adversities; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*Fourth Sunday after Trinity*

O GOD, the protector of all who trust in thee, without whom nothing is strong, nothing is holy; Increase and multiply upon us your mercy; that, you being our ruler and guide, we may so pass through the good things temporal, that we do not at the last lose the things eternal: Grant this, O heavenly Father, for the sake of Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*Fifth Sunday after Trinity*

GRANT, O Lord, we entreat you, that the course of this world may be so peaceably ordered by your governance, that your Church may joyfully serve you in all godly quietness; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

LORD of all power and might, the author and giver of all good things; Graft in our hearts the love of your Name, increase in us true religion, nourish us with all goodness, and in your great mercy keep us in the same; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*Eighth Sunday after Trinity*

O GOD, whose never-failing providence orders all things both in heaven and earth; We humbly entreat you to put away from us all hurtful things, and to give us those things which are profitable for us; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*Ninth Sunday after Trinity*

GRANT to us, Lord, we entreat you, the spirit to think and do always such things as are rightful; that we, who cannot do any thing that is good without you, may by you be enabled to live according to your will; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*Tenth Sunday after Trinity*

LET your merciful ears, O Lord, be open to the prayers of your humble servants; and that they may obtain their petitions, make them to ask such things as shall please you; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*Eleventh Sunday after Trinity*

O GOD, who do declare your almighty power most chiefly in showing mercy and pity; Mercifully grant us such a measure of your grace, that we, running the way of your commandments, may obtain your gracious promises, and be made partakers of your heavenly treasure; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*Twelfth Sunday after Trinity*

ALMIGHTY and everlasting God, who are always more ready to hear than we are to pray, and are apt to give more than either we desire, or deserve; Pour down upon us the abundance of your mercy; forgiving us those things for which our conscience is afraid, and giving us those good things which we are not worthy to ask, except through the merits and mediation of Jesus Christ, your Son, our Lord. *Amen.*

*Thirteenth Sunday after Trinity*

ALMIGHTY and merciful God, of whose gift alone it comes that your faithful people do you true and laudable service; Grant, we entreat you, that we may so faithfully serve you in this life, that we do not fail at the last to attain your heavenly promises; through the merits of Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*Fourteenth Sunday after Trinity*

ALMIGHTY and everlasting God, give us the increase of faith, hope, and charity; and, that we may obtain that which you promise, make us to love that which you command; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*Fifteenth Sunday after Trinity*

KEEP, we entreat you, O Lord, your Church with your perpetual mercy: and, because the frailty of man without you cannot but fall, keep us ever by your help from all things hurtful, and lead us to all things profitable to our salvation; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*Sixteenth Sunday after Trinity*

O LORD, we entreat you, let your continual pity cleanse and defend your Church; and, because it cannot continue in safety without your assistance, preserve it evermore by your help and goodness; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*Seventeenth Sunday after Trinity*

LORD, we call upon you that your grace may always precede and follow us, and make us continually to be given to all good works; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*Eighteenth Sunday after Trinity*

LORD, we entreat you, grant your people the grace to withstand the temptations of the world, the flesh, and the devil, and with pure hearts

and minds to follow you the only God; through Jesus Christ our Lord.  
*Amen.*

*Nineteenth Sunday after Trinity*

O GOD, forasmuch as without you we are unable to please you; Mercifully grant, that your Holy Spirit may in all things direct and rule our hearts; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*Twentieth Sunday after Trinity*

O ALMIGHTY and most merciful God, in your bountiful goodness keep us, we entreat you, from all things that may hurt us; that we, being ready both in body and soul, may cheerfully accomplish those things that you would have done; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*Twenty-First Sunday after Trinity*

GRANT to your faithful people, we entreat you, merciful Lord, your pardon and peace, that they may be cleansed from all their sins, and serve you with an untroubled mind; through Jesus Christ our Lord.  
*Amen.*

*Twenty-Second Sunday after Trinity*

Lord, we entreat you to keep your household the Church in continual godliness; that through your protection it may be free from all adversities, and devoutly given to serve you in good works, to the glory of your Name; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*Twenty-Third Sunday after Trinity*

O GOD, our refuge and strength, who are the author of all godliness; Be ready, we entreat you, to hear the devout prayers of your Church; and grant that those things which we ask faithfully we may obtain effectually; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*Twenty-Fourth Sunday after Trinity*

O LORD, we entreat you, absolve your people from their offenses; that through your bountiful goodness we may all be delivered from



the bonds of those sins, which by our frailty we have committed: Grant this, O heavenly Father, for the sake of Jesus Christ, our blessed Lord and Savior. *Amen.*

*Sunday next before Advent*

STIR up, we entreat you, O Lord, the wills of your faithful people; that they, plenteously bringing forth the fruit of good works, may by you be plenteously rewarded; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*If there are still weeks left before this Collect is appointed, read what has not already been read in the weeks after the Epiphany.*

*Saint Andrew the Apostle*

ALMIGHTY God, who gave such grace to your holy Apostle Saint Andrew, that he readily obeyed the calling of your Son Jesus Christ, & followed him without delay; Grant to us all, that we, being called by your holy Word, may forthwith give up ourselves obediently to fulfill the holy commandments; through the same Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*Saint Thomas the Apostle*

ALMIGHTY and everliving God, who for the more confirmation of the faith did suffer your holy Apostle Thomas to be doubtful in your Son's resurrection; Grant us so perfectly, & without all doubt, to believe in your Son Jesus Christ, that our faith in your sight may never be reprov'd. Hear us, O Lord, through the same Jesus Christ, to whom, with you and the Holy Ghost, be all honor and glory, now and for evermore. *Amen.*

*The Conversion of Saint Paul*

O GOD, who, through the preaching of the blessed Apostle Saint Paul, have caused the light of the Gospel to shine throughout the world; Grant, we entreat you, that we, having his wonderful conversion in remembrance, may show forth our thankfulness to you for the same, by following the holy doctrine which he taught; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*The Presentation of Christ in the Temple*

ALMIGHTY & everliving God, we humbly entreat your Majesty, that, as your only-begotten Son was this day presented in the temple in substance of our flesh, so may we be presented to you with pure and clean hearts, by the same your Son Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*Saint Matthias the Apostle*

O ALMIGHTY God, who in the place of the traitor Judas chose your faithful servant Matthias to be of the number of the twelve Apostles; Grant that your Church, being always preserved from false Apostles, may be ordered and guided by faithful and true pastors; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*The Annunciation of the blessed Virgin Mary.*

WE entreat you, O Lord, pour your grace into our hearts; that, as we have known the incarnation of your Son Jesus Christ by the message of an angel, so by his cross and passion we may be brought to the glory of his resurrection; through the same Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*Saint Mark the Evangelist*

O ALMIGHTY God, who have instructed your holy Church with the heavenly doctrine of your Evangelist Saint Mark; Give us grace, that, not being like children carried away with every blast of vain doctrine, we may be established in the truth of your holy Gospel; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*Saint Philip and Saint James, Apostles*

O ALMIGHTY God, whom truly to know is everlasting life; Grant us perfectly to know your Son Jesus Christ to be the way, the truth, and the life; that, following the steps of your holy Apostles, Saint Philip & Saint James, we may steadfastly walk in the way that leads to eternal life; through the same your Son Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*Saint Barnabas the Apostle*

O LORD God Almighty, who did endue your holy Apostle Barnabas with singular gifts of the Holy Ghost; Do not leave us, we entreat you, destitute of your manifold gifts, nor yet of grace to use them always to your honor and glory; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*Saint Peter the Apostle*

with you, O Father, and you, O Holy Ghost, lives and reigns, one God, world without end. *Amen.*

*Saint Bartholomew the Apostle*

O ALMIGHTY and everlasting God, who gave to your Apostle Bartholomew grace, truly to believe and to preach your Word; Grant, we entreat you, to your Church, to love that Word which he believed, and both to preach and receive the same; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*Saint Matthew, Apostle and Evangelist*

O ALMIGHTY God, who by your blessed Son called Matthew from the receipt of taxes to be an Apostle and Evangelist; Grant us grace to forsake all covetous desires, and inordinate love of riches, and to follow the same your Son Jesus Christ, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Ghost, one God, world without end. *Amen.*

*Saint Michael and all Angels*

O EVERLASTING God, who have ordained and constituted the services of Angels & men in a wonderful order; Mercifully grant, that as your holy Angels always do you service in heaven, so by your appointment they may help and defend us on earth; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*Saint Luke the Evangelist*

ALMIGHTY God, who called Luke the Physician, whose glorying is in the Gospel, to be an Evangelist, and Physician of the soul; May it please you, that, by the wholesome medicines of the doctrine delivered by him, all the diseases of our souls may be healed; through the merits of your Son Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*Saint Simon and Saint Jude, Apostles*

O ALMIGHTY God, who have built your Church upon the foundation of the Apostles and Prophets, Jesus Christ himself being the head

cornerstone; Grant us so to be joined together in unity of spirit by their doctrine, that we may be made a holy temple acceptable to you; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

*All Saints' Day*

O ALMIGHTY God, who have knit together your elect in one communion and fellowship, in the mystical body of your Son Christ our Lord; Grant us grace so to follow your blessed Saints in all virtuous and godly living, that we may come to those unspeakable joys, which you have prepared for those who unfeignedly love you; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*
